3. When the magma spews out of the mouth of the volcano it is called chamber.
4. The more the volcanoes erupt the taller they grow
5. The volcanic eruption produces a cloud of thick ash that spreads around the volcano and helps animals and plants.
6. The conduit connects the chamber with the crater.
7. The flank is the side of the volcanic mountain.
8. A dormant volcano will never erupt again.
